the governing authority of a political unit

communist

relating to socialism that abolishes private ownership

vigilante

a person who takes the law into his or her own hands

atheist

someone who denies the existence of god

obliterate

remove completely from recognition or memory

compulsory

required by rule

illicit

contrary to accepted morality or convention

rampant

occurring or increasing in an unrestrained way

tactical

pertaining to detailed maneuvers to achieve objectives

haggard

showing the wearing effects of overwork or care or suffering

execution

putting a condemned person to death

inconsolable

sad beyond comforting

filial

designating the generation following the parental generation

defector

a person who abandons their duty (as on a military post)

asylum

a shelter from danger or hardship

despondency

feeling downcast and disheartened and hopeless

repatriate

send someone back to his homeland against his will
